Personal Computer Skills Chewy Project Directions

Situation: You have worked for Chewy Gum Corporation for several years and been informed that you are now eligible for promotion. Promotions at Chewy are determined by supervisor ratings and a written examination. To be promoted, you must score an average of 80 or above in four categories:

- Supervisor rating of leadership potential
- Supervisor rating of understanding of duties
- Supervisor rating of willingness to work hard
- Written test score

After receiving your supervisor ratings, you decide to prepare a spreadsheet to determine the minimum written test score needed for promotion.

- 1. Open the Chewy spreadsheet found on the desktop. Save the spreadsheet by adding your last name to the file name.
- 2. In cell B6, enter 70 as the supervisor rating; in B7, enter 85; and in B8, enter 80.
- 3. Enter a formula in B11 that determines the average of the values in B6:B9.
- 4. Format B11 for a number with zero places to the right of the decimal.
- 5. Format B11 for the following conditions:

Condition	Format
B11 is less than 80	The pattern of B11 is red
B11 is greater than or equal to 80	The pattern of B11 is green

- 6. Enter the following possible test scores in B9: 75, 80, 85, 90, 95. Which ones will result in a promotion? **Insert a cell comment to answer this question**.
