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COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic Schedule

The Niagara County Department of Health will be offering FREE COVID-19 vaccine at several sites.

All children ages **5-17** are eligible to receive **Pfizer-BioNTech** Vaccine. <u>Appointments are strongly</u> <u>recommended</u> and ALL children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

The CDC recommends that **mRNA COVID-19 vaccines** (i.e., Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna vaccines) **are preferred over the Janssen COVID-19 vaccine for the prevention of COVID-19 for all people age 18 years or older**. This recommendation applies to **both primary series and booster doses**.

NEW! COVID-19 booster doses are now recommended for <u>all individuals</u> ages 5 years and older as follows:

Initial Booster:

- **Pfizer-BioNTech:** All individuals **5** years of age and older at least **five** (**5**) months after completion of primary series
- Moderna: All individuals 18 years of age and older at least five (5) months after completion of primary series
- Janssen (J&J): All individuals 18 years of age and older at least two (2) months after completion of a one-dose Janssen primary series.

Additional Booster:

- Ages 50 years or older who have received a completed series and initial booster dose
- Ages 18 49 years and who received Janssen (Johnson & Johnson) as **BOTH** their initial vaccine series **AND** their initial booster dose.
- Ages 12 years or older and who are moderately to severely immunocompromised as defined below:
 - Active treatment for solid tumor and hematologic malignancies
 - Receipt of solid-organ transplant and taking immunosuppressive therapy
 - Receipt of CAR-T-cell or hematopoietic stem cell transplant (within 2 years of transplantation or taking immunosuppression therapy)
 - Moderate or severe primary immunodeficiency (e.g., DiGeorge syndrome, Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome)
 - Advanced or untreated HIV infection
 - Active treatment with high-dose corticosteroids (i.e., at least 20 mg prednisone or equivalent per day), alkylating agents, antimetabolites, transplant-related immunosuppressive drugs, cancer chemotherapeutic agents classified as severely immunosuppressive, tumor-necrosis (TNF) blockers, and other biologic agents that are immunosuppressive or immunomodulatory.

Initial Booster doses and Additional Booster doses for Pfizer, J&J and Moderna are available at each location. **Pre-registration is recommended.**

Vaccinations for 3rd/additional doses for moderately to severely immunocompromised individuals are available as well, pre-registration is not required. Please notify a member of our staff upon arrival at the clinic.

If you are registering for a booster dose, please have your vaccine card available, you will be asked to confirm your previous vaccination dates.

Second Dose Pfizer Appointments:

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All individuals that receive a 1st dose at a Niagara County DOH clinic, will be informed of the earliest date the 2nd dose is recommended. Second doses should be administered as follows: For individuals 5+ that received **Pfizer**– schedule the 2nd dose *at least 21* days *after* the 1st dose. For individuals 18+ that received **Moderna** – schedule the 2nd dose *at least 28* days *after* the 1st dose

Vaccination of Minors:

All individuals **age 5 and older** are eligible to receive a <u>**Pfizer**</u> COVID-19 vaccine. NCDOH recommends that *all* minors be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Providers may accept a COVID-19 Immunization Screening and Consent Form completed by the parent or guardian, where the parent or guardian is not available in person or by phone to provide consent to vaccinate. Look for the form under "Vaccination of Minors Ages 5 – 17 Years" here: <u>www.niagaracounty.com/health/Vaccine</u> Unaccompanied minors should also bring ID/proof of date of birth (birth certificate, passport, learning permit/driver's license, benefits care, etc.).

Recommendations for Boosters:

There are now booster recommendations for all three available COVID-19 vaccines in the United States. Eligible individuals may choose which vaccine they receive as a booster dose. Some people may have a preference for the vaccine type that they originally received, and others may prefer to get a different booster. CDC's recommendations now allow for this type of mix and match dosing for booster shots.

Initial Booster

- For individuals **5**+ who received a **Pfizer-BioNTech** COVID-19 vaccine, a booster is recommended at <u>5</u> <u>months</u> or more after their initial series
- For individuals **18**+ that received a **Moderna** COVID-19 vaccine, a booster is recommended at <u>5</u> months or more after completion of the initial series.
- For individuals **18**+ who received a **Johnson & Johnson (Janssen**) COVID-19 vaccine, a booster shot is recommended <u>**2 months**</u> after the initial dose.

Additional Booster:

- Ages 50 years or older who have received a completed series and initial booster dose
- Ages 18 49 years and who received Janssen (Johnson & Johnson) as **BOTH** their initial vaccine series **AND** their initial booster dose.
- Ages 12 years or older and who are moderately to severely immunocompromised as defined below:
